SUBJECT: PLANNING AUGMENTATION FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2009-10  
TITLE IV-E CHILD WELFARE WAIVER DEMONSTRATION CAPPED  
ALLOCATION PROJECT (CAP)

REFERENCE: CFL NO. 09/10-39, DATED JANUARY 26, 2010

The purpose of this letter is to provide Alameda and Los Angeles Counties with a planning augmentation to the FY 2009-10 allocation for the Title IV-E Child Welfare Waiver Demonstration CAP that was approved by the federal Department of Health and Human Services on March 31, 2006, and was implemented on July 1, 2007. Contingent upon approval of the FY 2009-10 budget adjustments, the attachments represent the augmentation based on the recently released Governor's Budget. Alameda and Los Angeles Counties will be notified when the figures in the provided attachments become final.

The attachments display the initial capped allocation for federal Title IV-E, General Fund, and county funds that were established upon approval of Alameda and Los Angeles Counties' participation in the CAP, and provided in CFL NO. 09/10-39, dated January 26, 2010. Attachment I displays the FY 2009-10 Waiver Base allocation, American Recovery and Reinvestment Act – Federal Medical Assistance Percentage Increase, Foster Care 101, Non-Base Waiver, and Non-Waiver activities for Alameda County. Attachment II displays the same information for Los Angeles County.
