COUNTY FISCAL LETTER (CFL) NO. 10/11-19

SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2010-11 ADOPTIONS INCENTIVES PROGRAM  
(AIP) FEDERALLY FUNDED PLANNING ALLOCATION

REFERENCE: CFL NO. 09/10-66E, DATED 07/01/10

The purpose of this letter is to inform counties of the FY 2010-11 planning allocation for AIP. A total of \$1,445,711 in federal funds will be made available for this program contingent upon approval of the FY 2010-11 Budget Act.

The Adoptions Incentive allocation methodology is based on the percent to total of the Adoption and Foster Care Analysis and Reporting System (AFCARS) caseload growth of each individual permanency outcome between Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2008 and FFY 2009. The permanency outcomes include: Adoptions, Kin-GAP, Other Guardianship, and Second Chance Reunification of children with parents whose reunification services were previously terminated.

Costs will be funded with 100 percent federal Title IV-E funds. Program Code 151 has been re-established to capture activities when serving a child in a finalized adoptive home. Any expenditure exceeding the allocation will be shifted to county-only using State Use Only Code 152. Please see CFL No. 09/10-66E for additional claiming instructions.
