AND RESPONSIBILITY TO KIDS (CalWORKs) SINGLE  
ALLOCATION (SA) AUGMENTATION AND REDISTRIBUTION

This letter informs counties of the FY 2010-11 augmentation and redistribution for the CalWORKs SA. Attachment I displays the revised FY 2010-11 CalWORKs SA funds. The augmentation amount identified within Attachment I reflects the revised CalWORKs SA for FY 2010-11 based on the May Revision.

Attachment I displays an augmentation in the amount of \$2.6 million plus \$207,000 for mailing notifications for a total FY 2010-11 augmentation of \$2.8 million. Also displayed is a redistribution of funds in the amount of \$4,806,330.

The \$207,000 is to fund the cost of notifying CalWORKs recipients who are receiving Stage One Child Care of changes to subsidized child care programs pursuant to Senate Bill 70 (Chapter 7, Statutes of 2011) as described in ACL No. 11-38, dated April 19, 2011. Per Attachment I, the amount of \$207,000 for mailing notifications was distributed based on county size. The very small, small, medium, and large counties each received an allocation of \$500, \$1,000, \$2,000, and \$10,357 respectively.

The remaining augment in the amount of \$2.6 million was distributed based on a percent-to-total of each county's FY 2010-11 CalWORKs SA as displayed within CFL No. 10/11-55, dated April 6, 2011.

The FY 2010-11 CalWORKs SA redistribution in the amount of \$4,806,330 has been redistributed as requested by the County Welfare Directors Association (CWDA). The

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CWDA determined the redistribution of funding amongst counties to ensure the maximum expenditure rate of available funds.

The augmented and redistributed funds have been added to the counties' total SA rather than to any of the individual components within the allocation. Counties have the flexibility to use the funds interchangeably between individual components.
