The purpose of this letter is to provide counties with a revised FY 2001/02 WtW Grant Match Allocation due to FY 2000/01 WtW Grant Match closeout process.

Attached is a display of counties FY 2001/02 revised allocation. Column II displays the allocation provided in CFL 01/02-18. Column III displays the closeout rollover from FY 2000/01. Column IV displays the revised FY 01/02 allocation.

The allocation will be applied to eligible WtW expenditures reported to Program Code 642, Federal WtW Grant Program Match funds on the County Expense Claim. Expenditures that exceed the revised State allocation will be transferred to county only share through State Use Only Program Code 659 for WtW Grant Matching funds.
