SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2005/06 ADOPTIONS COUNTY COUNSEL (ACC)
STATE GENERAL FUND (SGF) PLANNING ALLOCATION

Contingent upon approval of the State Budget, the amount identified on the enclosed attachment is your planning allocation for the ACC Program. It is anticipated that a total of \$870,000 in SGF will be made available upon approval of the FY 2005/06 Budget Act.

The funds were distributed based on a percent to total of each county's ACC expenditures for calendar year 2004.

The expenditures claimed as a direct charge to Program Identifier Number (PIN) Code 567052 or PIN Code 568052 on the quarterly CEC will be tracked against the allocation. Any expenditure exceeding the allocation will be shifted to county only share using State Use Only Code 512.
