SUBJECT: GREATER AVENUES FOR INDEPENDENCE (GAIN)
PERFORMANCE OUTCOMES REPORT

REFERENCE: COUNTY FISCAL LETTER NO. 96/97-20

Part 1 of the GAIN Performance Outcomes Report (GAIN 107) is entitled "Job Retention, Wage Level and Hours Worked." During the 1996/97 state fiscal year, the submission of this report by counties was voluntary, but beginning in July 1997, all counties were scheduled to submit the GAIN 107 to the Information Services Bureau.

Recent welfare reform developments will require a revision of the necessary data collected by the GAIN reporting process. These revisions will occur in the months following the passage of a California Welfare Reform Bill and will include a reconfiguration of the data elements collected by the GAIN 107. In order to eliminate any further work by counties on a new report that will be revised soon, the GAIN 107 report is being terminated. Counties will not have to submit the GAIN 107 report for the 1997/98 state fiscal year.
