### **TO REPORT SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE OR NEGLECT BY PARENT OR OTHER CARETAKER HAVING CUSTODY**

If you suspect that a child's health or safety is jeopardized due to abuse or neglect by parents or another caretaker who has custody of the child, contact the appropriate [Emergency Responce Hotline Number For County Child Protective Services](#) to report the details. The appropriate county CWS agency is the county where the child lives. These telephone numbers are also available in the County Government section of the local telephone directory, or you can call 911 for emergencies.
